



A Polk County Public Charter School serving ages 3 thru Grade 6

Florida Statute requires charter schools that do not receive a school grade but serve at least 10 students who were tested on the FCAT 2013 statewide assessment to report student performance data.

In order to receive a school grade of “A” from the Florida Department of Education a school must receive 525 points.
